

**PEQUEA TOWNSHIP

Minutes of – June 12, 2013**

The members of Pequea Township Park and Recreation Board met on Wednesday, June 12, 2013 at 7:00 pm in the conference room of the Pequea Township Municipal Building, 1028 Millwood Road, Willow Street, PA 17584.

**Call To Order:** Meeting was called to order by Chair, Steve Gogoj, at 7:00 pm with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Minutes Review:** Minutes of the May 8, 2013 meeting were reviewed. Steve Gogoj made a motion to accept the minutes from the May 8, 2013 meeting, as written. Janet Hess seconded the motion, all voted in favor, none opposed.

**Unfinished Business:** None

**New Business:**

- 1) ACCA Reliability Tour - A motion by Steve Gogoj was made to recommend to the BOS, the approval of the ACCA Reliability Tour for the week of June 15-21, 2014 giving permission, as presented, to enter the park from the lower end gate, driving through the water to the lower peninsula. They should be allowed to park on the grass, weather permitting, otherwise parking will have to be on the macadam. They will have approximately 75 cars for an ice cream social event. Motion was seconded by Earl Houghton, all voted in favor, none opposed.
- 2) Approval for Carl Lefever and Adam Gill to plant Memorial trees - A motion was made to recommend to the Board of Supervisors to approve memorial trees planted by Carl Lefever and Adam Gill.
- 3) Request by Tim Weaver to sell crafts in the upper pavilion by the playground was discussed and a recommendation that the township secretary, Connie Kauffman, should research to find out if this would be allowable.
- 4) Young Lungs at Play Sign (a no smoking sign) - The Park Board recommends to the Board of Supervisors that a Young Lungs at Play Sign would be permitted at the playground.

**Board Comments:** None


**Public Comments:**
