New Business:



 - The Parks Board is putting out a call for volunteers to help with the fundraising of the Flag Pole Memorial. Any interested residents are asked to contact the township secretary or Mr. Gogoj at steveg46@comcast.net.
 - Four colors of hats along with a flag pin will be given to anyone who donates \$25.00 or more to the Flag Pole fundraising fund. Hat colors are gray, orange, or camouflage.
 - Mr. Houghton will contact Conestoga Township to see if he can get on their agenda announcing the Flag Pole Memorial at the Pequea Silver Mine Park as many of their residents also enjoy the use of the park.
