**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
PEQUEA TOWNSHIP, LANCASTER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, DETERMINING THE FORM OF
NOTICE OF TREE REMOVAL TO ABUTTING
PROPERTY OWNERS.**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors is authorized pursuant to Section 2325 of the Second Class Township Code to remove trees and shrubs growing within the right-of-way provided those trees and shrubs constitute a hazardous condition or impair the use of the public roadway; and

WHEREAS, abutting property owners shall be notified prior to the removal of trees having a trunk diameter in excess of six (6) inches; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors shall determine the form of notice to abutting property owners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pequea, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to Section 2325 of the Second Class Township Code, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby determines the notice of tree removal to abutting property owners shall be in writing.

Section 2. Notice shall be mailed to the abutting property owner to take corrective action to remove the tree or shrub creating a hazard in the Township Right-of-Way within 30 days of the date of the notice. The property owner shall be invoiced the cost of the removal for failure to comply.

Section 3. Notice shall only be required for the removal of trees with a trunk diameter greater than six (6) inches growing in the right-of-way.

Section 4. The provisions in this Resolution are severable, and if any section, sentence, clause, part, or provision hereof shall be held to be illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision of the court shall not affect or impair the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, parts, or provisions of this Resolution. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors that this Resolution would have been

adopted if such illegal, invalid, or unconstitutional section, sentence, clause, part, or provision had not been included herein.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Board of Supervisors.
