# 6. <u>Discuss Bid Packages for budgeted General Fund and Highway (State) Fund Road and Bridge work</u> in 2023

- A. Vice-Chairman Haas moved to authorize the secretary to advertise the acceptance of bid packages for the following roads from the General Fund: Run Valley Rd.-base repair-Marticville Rd. to the Township line, Clearview Rd.-base repair-Indian Hill Rd. to Millwood Rd., Linestown Rd.-base repair and pipe restoration, Shultz Rd.-base repair-Millwood Rd. to bridge, and Mohawk Dr.-base repair. Chairman Lehman seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.
- B. Vice-Chairman Haas moved to authorize the secretary to advertise the acceptance of bid packages for the road work from the Highway Fund: Baumgardner Rd.-wearing and leveling course-Rt. 272 to Millwood Rd. and Silver Mine Rd.-base repair-Marticville Rd. to Township Line. Chairman Lehman seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

#### 7. Discuss Fire Companies request for fuel donations

Supervisor Lucas moved to table this agenda item. Vice-Chairman Haas seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed. During discussion, Chairman Lehman gave some history on fire company funds from the Township and his desire to allow the fire companies to spend funds as they see fit as they are good managers of their funds. Any increase will be considered at the 2023 Budget Workshop. Vice-Chairman Haas requested fire company balance sheets prior to the Budget Workshop. Supervisor Lucas pointed out that this years' Township contribution to the fire companies was an increase of 11.5%.

## 8. <u>Discuss transfer of General Fund monies to PLIGIT Plus Account / CD</u> -Resolution #637-2023 and Resolution #638-2023
