1. Consider approving the minutes of the September 20, 2023 Board of Supervisors Ordinance Hearing Meeting.

Vice-Chairman Haas moved to approve the minutes of the September 20, 2023 Board of Supervisors Ordinance Hearing Meeting. Supervisor Novak seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

Supervisor Lucas moved to approve checks #14778-14821 from the General Fund/ checks #2074-2083 from the Recreation Fund and 2-EFT's from the Capital Reserve Fund. Vice-Chairman Haas seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. Consider Line of Credit reduction request #1 from Northwest Bank LOC#8305005111 for 24 Leaman Road (Dan Evans) per Solanco Engineering Review #1 of 10/5/23

Supervisor Lucas moved that Pequea Township reduce the escrow for Dan Evans, 24 Leaman Rd., Escrow Release #1 by \$62,066.72 and establish the new amount equal to \$2,750.00. Vice-Chairman Haas seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

2. Consider Vanguard Dev. Group Line of Credit reduction request #6 from Mid-Penn Bank LOC #966 for Stage 2 Willow Acres

Supervisor Lucas moved that Pequea Township release the remaining financial security for Willow Acres-Stage 2, Letter of Credit Reduction-Request #6, Letter of Credit #966-Mid Penn Bank. Vice-Chairman Haas seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

3. Consider Vanguard Dev. Group Line of Credit reduction request #6 from Mid-Penn Bank LOC #965 for Stage 3 Willow Acres

Supervisor Lucas moved that we release all remaining financial security for Willow Acres-Stage 3, Letter of Credit Reduction-Request #6, Letter of Credit #965-Mid Penn Bank. Chairman Lehman seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

4. Consider compensation for Township employee, Craig Mellinger

Vice-Chairman Haas moved to compensate Craig Mellinger \$200.00 for management duties performed during the road master's absence. Chairman Lehman seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

Supervisor Lucas and Chairman Lehman commented on how fortunate Pequea Township is to have such dedicated employees willing to step up and do extra when needed.

5. Consider Stormwater Plan SWM2023-2 per Solanco Engineering Review #3 of 9/25/23 for 77 Herrville Road (Brent Risser)

Supervisor Lucas made 4 separate consecutive related motions. Chairman Lehman seconded each motion in turn and each motion was approved 5 aye-0 nay, in turn.

**Motion (1):** I move that Pequea Township approve Brent Risser's 77 Herrville Rd. Subdivision and Land Development Waiver request, Sections 305 and 3066, for Preliminary and Final Plan. **Motion (2):** I move that Pequea Township approve Brent Risser's 77 Herrville Rd. Management

Ordinance Waiver request, Section 506.1.B.3, for Loading Ratios.

Motion (3): I move that Pequea Township approve Brent Risser's 77 Herrville Rd. Management Ordinance Waiver request, Section 504.4.a.4, for Pipe Size.

**Motion (4):** I move that Pequea Township approve Brent Risser's 77 Herrville Rd. New Driveway Ordinance Waiver request, Section 6.B, for Driveway Dimensions.

6. Consider Stormwater Plan SWM2023-3 per Solanco Engineering Review #2 of 10/10/23 for 189 Marticville Road (Cody Harnish)

Supervisor Lucas moved to approve Cody Harnish's 189 Marticville Rd. Stormwater Management Plan waiver request for Section 501.18.E for a carbonate geology report. Supervisor Novak seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

7. Consider request by Marty Glackin to place a memorial tree (Red Bud) in Silver Mine Park

Chairman Lehman moved that we approve Marty Glackkin's request to plant a redbud tree in Silver Mine Park. Supervisor Novak seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

8. Appoint a Certified Public Accountant to Audit the 2023 Accounts of the Township of Pequea and establish compensation to be paid (Approx. \$12,200.00) to the CPA via Resolution

Vice-Chairman Haas moved to approve **Resolution #659-2023** to hire MaherDuesssel CPA in the approximate amount of \$12,200.00 to examine all the accounts of the Township for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2023. Chairman Lehman seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

9. Consider submitting PA DCED Grant Application for new Dump Truck via Resolution

Vice-Chairman Haas moved to approve Resolution #660-2023, a Resolution by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Pequea, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania, designating Two Officials to Execute All Documents and Request Grant. Be it Resolved, that Pequea Township of Lancaster County hereby request a Statewide Local Share Assessment grant of \$239,405.00 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority to be used for a New Dump Truck. Be it further resolved that the applicant does hereby designate Harry D. Lehman III (Chairman) and Dawn Rineer (Administrator) as the officials to execute all documents and agreements between Pequea

Chairman Lehman seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

# 10. Consider modification of Fee Schedule to clarify dog violation fees via Resolution

Chairman Lehman moved to pass **Resolution #661-2023 whereas the Township wishes to amend the Township Fee Schedule by Resolution**. Supervisor Novak seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

# 11. Consider Pequea Township Police Department disposition of records via Resolution

Chairman Lehman moved to pass Resolution #662-2023; whereas, by virtue of Resolution #334-2010, adopted July 21, 2010, that Pequea Township declared its intent to follow the schedules and procedures for the disposition of records as set forth in the Municipal Records Manual approved December 16, 2008, (as amended March 28, 2019). Vice-Chairman Haas seconded the motion. All voted in favor; none opposed.

## 12. Consider Ordinance of Plan Amendment for Pequea Township Police Pension Plan

Chairman Lehman moved to have a hearing on Ordinance #222-2023, an Ordinance of Pequea Township, Lancaster County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Electing to Amend Its Police Pension Plan Administered by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System Pursuant to Article IV of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law; Agreeing to be Bound by All Provisions of the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law as Amended and As Applicable to Member Municipalities. It is Hereby Ordained by Pequea Township, Lancaster County. The hearing date will be December 20, 2023 at 6:30 pm. Vice-Chairman Haas seconded the motion. All voted in favor, none opposed.
